

LTPOA: Aquatic Plant Control

Skimmer policy

The Lake Templene Property Owners Association will provide or contract for *Limited* skimming and floating plant removal. The focus of this service will be to:

1. Collect large masses of floating weeds in the main body of the lake outside of the dockline affecting navigation.
2. Maintain navigable channels in the most plant choked areas of the lake.

The skimmer will :

1. Not operate in water depths less than 3 feet
2. pick up only what the boat can collect in a sweep. However, if a property owner has an individual available to rake plants away from obstructions and on to the pickup conveyor we will collect and dispose of them. Contact Chase Wenzel to coordinate pickup.
3. not collect close to, between or around piers, docks and boats.

The skimmer will be operated as needed for the association on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. On a routine basis it will be scheduled to collect in a specific third of the lake. However as needs arise it can be redirected to problem areas. This is a trial plan and will develop as needs and practice define.

Initially we plan to operate as follows:

Mondays- North of the Findley Rd bridge

Tuesdays- Findley Rd. bridge Through Timber Trace/Hickory Hills

Wednesdays- West end of the lake

Additional shoreline cleanup will be available on a private pay basis. To contract for private shoreline cleanup on a private pay basis please contact Chase Wenzel:
