## Michigan Watercraft Regulations and Safety Tips

- 1. Registration must be carried and displayed upon request.
- 2. The lanyard of a PWC (personal watercraft or jet ski) ignition safety switch must be attached to the person, clothing or life jacket of the operator.
- 3. It is illegal to operate a PWC between the time of sunset and 8:00 am. Sunset is the time determined by the National Weather Service.
- 4. PWC's must always operate in reasonable and prudent manner. It is illegal to jump the wake of another vessel or operate too close to another vessel.
- 5. All watercrafts shall not operate within 100 feet of a dock or raft, buoyed swimming area, persons in the water and anchored or drifting vessels.
- 6. Life jackets must be worn on PWCs. Children under the age of 6 must wear a life jacket when on the open deck of any boat. ALL watercrafts must carry enough life preservers for each passenger. This includes canoes, kayaks, and paddle boards.
- 7. PWC operators at least 16 years of age and born after December 31,1978, may legally operate a PWC **only if** they have obtained a boating safety certificate. Those born before December 31, 1978 may operate a PWC legally without those restrictions.
- 8. All watercrafts must operate in a COUNTERCLOCKWISE direction around the lake. Keep the shoreline to your right.
- 9. Do not chase or harass any wildlife.

- 10. Look behind you before turning.
- 11. Do not operate watercraft while intoxicated.
- 12. Respect the peace and quiet of the lake residents.
- 13. NO power means NO steering control. There are no brakes on moving watercraft.
